

WILSON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

Meeting Recap  of August 4, 2025 Meeting
of selected items



- Tomi Meachum, Wilson County WIC Nutrition Program Director and Breastfeeding Coordinator, presented a Proclamation recognizing August 1-7 as National WIC Breastfeeding Week. Commissioners approved this proclamation.
- Sheriff Calvin Woodard, presented a request to award badge and service weapon to Corporal James Averette, who retired on June 30, 2025, which was approved by Commissioners.
- Commissioners approved a rezoning request after a Public Hearing was held for Rezoning Request REZ-25-03 from AR (Agriculture Residential) Zoning District to R-30MH (Rural Manufactured Home District) Zoning District. Property location: intersection of Aycocks Crossing Rd (SR1661)/Leisure Rd.
- After a Public Hearing was held, Commissioners approved a Unified Development Ordinance amendment for Section 8.3 Accessory Structures.
- Commissioners approved a Unified Development Ordinance amendment regulating the location and operation of vape shops and hemp dispensaries in unincorporated areas of the county to ensure the health and safety of residents, maintain community standards, and ensure compatibility with surrounding land uses. This amendment updates the definition of Boarding House to include Multi Unit Assisted Housing with Services (MUAHS). The county can only regulate unincorporated areas, while the city of Wilson and towns have their own ordinances to enforce locations.
- Karye Blanchard, Wilson County Public Library Director, presented the revised Bylaws of the Wilson County Public Library Board of Trustees for the Board's approval.
- Commissioners adopted the Resolution for the Nash, Edgecombe, and Wilson County Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan and the 2025 Wilson County Emergency Operations Plan as presented by Gordon Deno, Emergency Management Director.
- Commissioners approved bids for the construction of Westside Phase 2 & 3 LCID and a request for a Capital Equipment Purchase as presented by Andy Davis, Solid Waste Services Director.
