

WILSON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

Meeting Recap  of July 7, 2025 Meeting
of selected items



- Melissa Worley was reappointed as Clerk to the Board and Antawn Hammonds was appointed as Deputy Clerk to the Board.
- A public hearing was held for the renewal of Franchise Agreement with MedEx Medical Transportation, Inc. for the provision of non-emergency ambulance services in Wilson County.
- A public hearing was held to adopt the resolution declaring the intent of the County to participate in the Commercial Property Assessed Capital Expenditure (C-PACE Program).
- Jennifer Lantz, Economic Development Council Director, presented a Resolution Approving a Stormwater Pond at Campus at 587 and the Board approved.
- Paolo Ceyrolles, Planning Analyst, presented a request by Stocks Engineering, PA for applicant FD Raleigh, Inc. and property owner Z Royce Bisette, to consider approval of a preliminary plat for a major subdivision consisting of approximately 185.35 acres into 94 lots located at 4540 Tartts Mill Road bordering Landfill Road and Sawdust Road and also presented a request by HerringSutton & Associates, PA on behalf of property owner, Karl L. Knight to consider approval of a preliminary plat for a subdivision consisting of 10.55 acres into 4 lots at 5071 Weaver Rd. The Board approved both requests.
- Gordon Deno, Emergency Management Director, presented a resolution approving the inclusion of the territorial limits of the Town of Lucama in the Crossroads Rural Fire Protection District for the Board's consideration. The request was approved.
- Michael Cobb, Emergency Services Director, presented a multi-year warranty contract with Zoll Medical Corporation for AutoPulse devices. The contract was approved.
- Crawford Bolton, Tax Administrator, presented a multi-year contract with Just Appraised, Inc. and a multi-year contract with Pictometry International Corp. Both contracts were approved.
- A resolution was presented for the County to purchase 4.5 acres at 4407 NC Hwy 581 in Sims for \$160,000 for possible future expansion of utilities and other services. The resolution was approved.
