

WILSON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

Meeting Recap  of June 2, 2025 Meeting
of selected items



- Michael Cobb, Emergency Medical Services Director, requested a Call for Public Hearing on Monday, July 7, 2025, at 7:00PM for a renewal of the Franchise Agreement for MedEx Medical Transportation, Inc. for the Board's consideration.
- A public hearing was held for Conditional Rezoning Request CREZ-25-01. The property in question is along Countryside Rd. in Wilson, NC. It is currently zoned as AR (Agriculture Residential) and will be rezoned as M2-CD (Heavy Industrial - Conditional District) to allow for the construction and operation of a cement/concrete manufacturing facility.
- Brad Thompson, Development Services Director, presented ETJ Expansion 2501 to allow the City of Wilson to enlarge its extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ) by 187.25 acres into Wilson County. He also presented the 2025 Review Officer amendments for the Board's consideration.
- Dr. Keshia Howell, Senior Activity Center Director, presented the HCCBG budget and funding requests for FY 2025-2026 for the Board's consideration.
- Jennifer Lantz, Economic Development Council Director, presented Economic Incentives for Pamlico Air, Inc., Construct, Inc., and Nutrien Ag Solutions, Inc. for the Board's consideration.
- Jennifer Lantz, Economic Development Council Director, also presented a Resolution Declaring Intent of the County of Wilson to Participate in the Commercial Property Assessed Capital Expenditure (C-PACE) Program for the Board's consideration.
- Brajesh Tiwari, County Engineer, presented the Bids for the Sheriff's Office Training Facility for the Board's consideration and recommend that the bid be awarded to Farrior & Sons, Inc. for \$2,113,000. This project will be funded by American Rescue Plan funds.
- Angel Landrau, Financial Services Director, presented a Resolution Accepting the 2023 Appropriations Act Directed Projects Grant Offer and the Revision to the Wilson County Procurement Policy for the Board's consideration.
