- Angel Landrau, Financial Services Director, presented the Government Finance Officers Association Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting. Financial Services staff were recognized by Commissioners for their dedication to excellent financial management practices for the 13th consecutive year.
- Commissioners approved a resolution to proceed with installment financing for Frederick Douglass Elementary and Wilson County Capital Projects after Ted Cole, Senior Vice President of Davenport & Associates, conducted a Public Hearing.
- Ronnie Ford, Water Services Director, presented the Emergency Water Supply Agreement with the Town of Lucama for the Board's consideration and approval. This will allow the Town of Lucama to purchase water from Wilson County in the event of a natural disaster or for emergency use.
- Commissioners approved several items as presented by Brad Thompson, Development Services Director:
 - The Essential Single Family Rehabilitation Loan Pool Program (ESFRLP27). This \$182,000 grant was awarded to The City of Wilson from the NC Housing Finance Agency to provide members with funds to assist with the rehabilitation of moderately deteriorated homes owned and occupied by lower-income, special-needs households.
 - The Nash Edgecombe Wilson (N.E.W) Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan
 - MAS-25-06, a request by Stocks Engineering, PA for property owner RRT Development, LLC, for approval of a preliminary plat for a major subdivision consisting of approximately 44.92 acres into 33 lots on both sides of Fab Whitley Rd. in the Spring Hill Township.
- Lori Winstead, Deputy County Manager, introduced Julius Petaway as the new Veteran Services Officer. He began employment with the county on November 3, 2025.
