- The Board proclaimed May 17-23 as EMS Week in Wilson County. The proclamation was presented by Kyseem Powell, Emergency Medical Technician with Wilson County EMS.
- Dr. David Moody, JCPC Chair, presented the Wilson County Juvenile Crime Prevention Council Executive Summary for FY 2026-2027 for the Board's consideration.
- The Board approved the fourth of five annual appropriations of \$12,500 to Ajax Metal Forming Solutions, along with the first of seven economic incentives of \$37,500 to Reckitt Benckiser Health as presented by Jennifer Lantz, Economic Development Council Director.
- The Board approved awarding the construction bid of \$1,631,500 for the new EMS East Station to J.D. Beam, Inc. as presented by Brajesh Tiwari, County Engineer.
- Ron Hunt, County Manager, presented the recommended county budget (\$142,356,259) for FY2026-2027 for the Board's consideration. The Fiscal Year 2026-2027 budget as recommended is based upon a \$0.595 tax rate, which remains the same as the previous fiscal year with no increase. The Board of Commissioners will have the month of May to review and make changes to the proposed budget. A public hearing will be held on May 28 at 6:30 p.m. at the Wilson County Government Center. After that, Commissioners may approve the budget, which must be approved by June 30, 2026.
